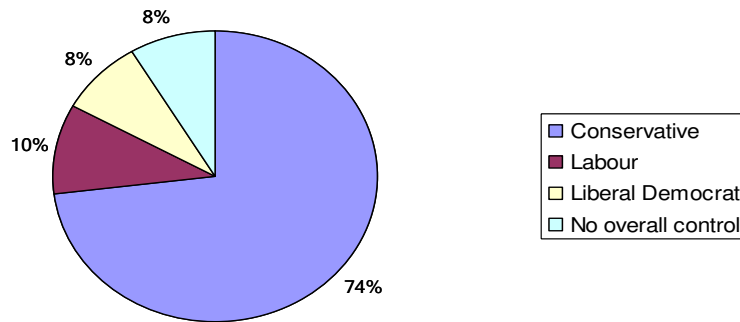

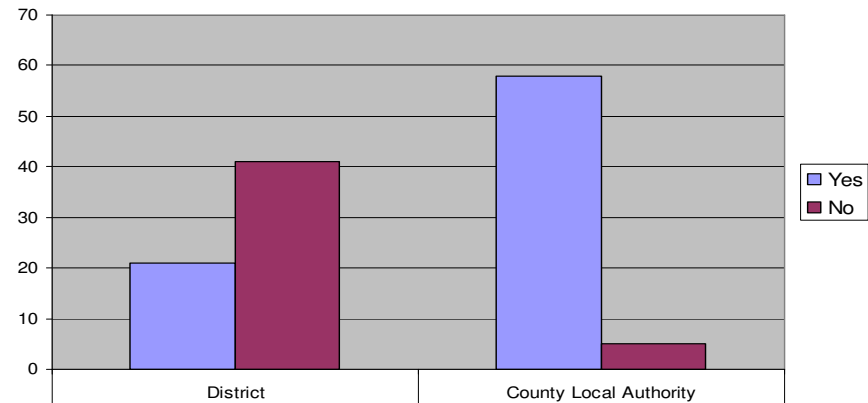


Survey live from the 2nd to the 17th November 2011: Total number of respondents = 73

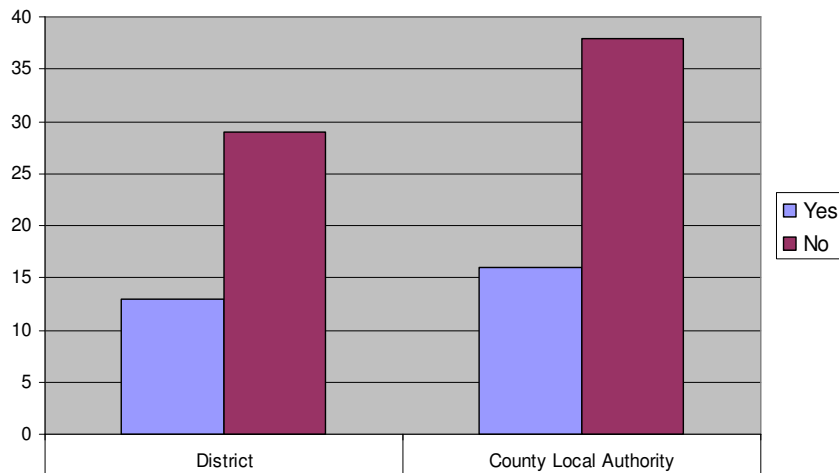
1) What is the political majority of your District Council?



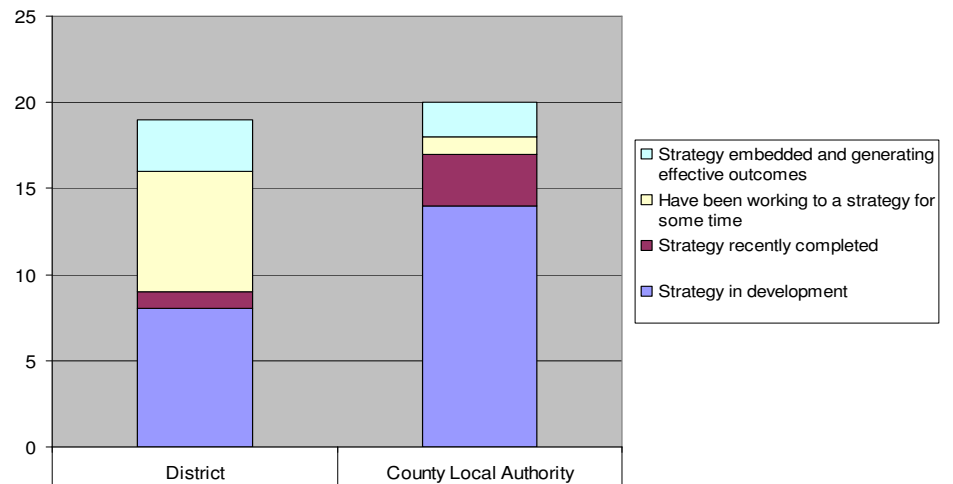
2) Do you have a Health and Wellbeing board for your District and /or County local authority area?



3) Have the boards developed a strategy?

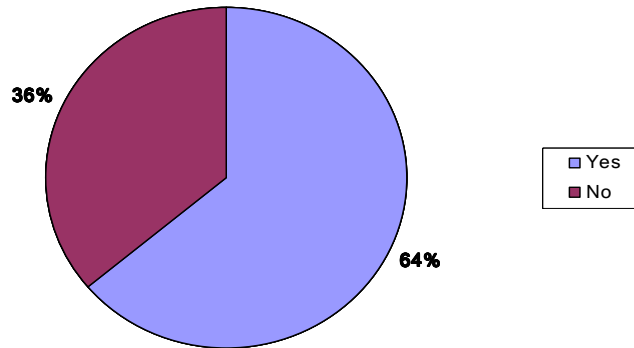


4) If you have a strategy, how would you assess its progress to date?



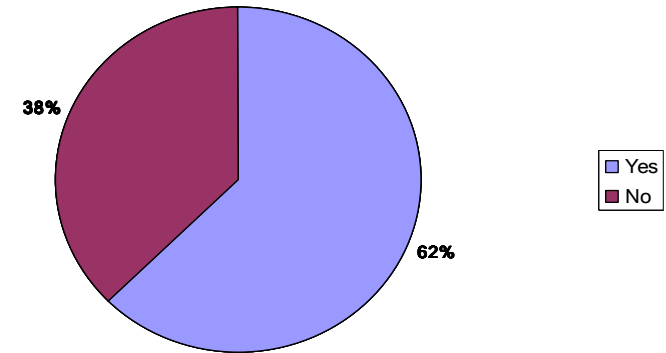
Appendix 3: DCN Health & Wellbeing Survey – Headline Results (5th December 2011)
